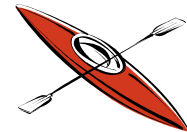


The TK Aqua Trek and the Oklawaha to Tanah Keeta Canoe Run!

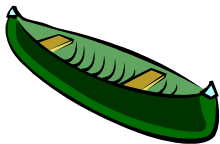
