

**TO ALL PERSONS USING****CAMP DARK HAMMOCK
CAMP RULES****Do Not Cross Fence Lines ~ Private Property**

Camp Dark Hammock is being leased by the Gulf Stream Council to provide natural Florida wilderness camping. Camp Dark Hammock is located northeast of Okeechobee City. See directions on the reverse side.

Reservations should be made at least two (2) weeks prior to your camping trip and through the Council Service Center (561-694-8585). You will also need a tour permit. There is a limit of no more than three (3) troops at one time. This is Troop, Crew or Explorer Post camping only.

In addition to the safety guidelines set forth by National and Council these also apply:

1. Bring drinking water.
2. Pets, firearms and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
3. Gathering of downed wood for campfires is permitted.
4. Electronic games, radios are not permitted.
5. Adult leaders should stay with the group at all times to provide two-deep leadership. Co-ed Explorer Posts and Venturing Crews require male and female advisor leadership.
6. All living plants are protected. Plants are not to be bent, broken, cut or defaced with initials. No live trees will be cut without permission from the Campmaster.
7. All campfires will be kept small and will be in the center of a 10-foot cleared fire circle.
8. Sanitary facilities - Campers may use the single outhouse provided by the Camp. Temporary latrines or pits are allowed.
9. Garbage - All trash and garbage will be taken with you on your departure.
10. Campers should remain in their respective campsites after dark, unless approved by adult leaders.
11. Quiet hours begin at 11:00 PM. Campers should be in their campsites and quiet.
12. All animals and fish are protected. Do not feed or molest. This applies to the dogs around the owner's trailer. DO NOT allow them to go into your campsite. If the dogs follow you, tell them in a loud and stern voice "GO HOME". Fishing is allowed; however, please practice catch-and-release.
13. Swimming is allowed in the pond. Safe swim procedures will be used.
14. Check-out Inspection - A Campmaster may inspect your site before you check-out at the designated departure time to see that you have left it clean and well kept.
