What is the National Jamboree?

Every four years, the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America organizes the ultimate Boy Scout experience, the National Jamboree! The BSA has announced that the next Jamboree has been scheduled in 2010 to coincide with the 100th birthday of the Boy Scouts of America! Yes, it will have been one hundred years since an "unknown Scout" helped an American businessman, William D. Boyce, to find his way through a London fog. This simple, selfless act led Mr. Boyce to bring the fledgling movement of Boy Scouting to America in 1910.

Over 40,000 Scouts and Scouters attended the last Jamboree in 2005, and all the excitement of past Jamborees will be incorporated with new themes and shows. What goes on at a Jamboree? Everything that the combined resources of the National Council plus hundreds of the best volunteers from every local council can provide! For example: 5K Fun Runs, 4-way volleyball, rifle shooting, Action Alley, bikathlon's, Buckskin Games, confidence courses, bicycle motocross, pioneering, rappelling towers, trapshooting, fishing, canoe slalom, scuba diving, kayaking, a **huge** merit badge midway, daily stage shows and the Order of the Arrow American Indian Village, plus much more!

Qualifications:

A Scout must have completed the sixth grade or be at least 12 years of age by July 1, 2010, have attained the rank of First Class by July 1, 2010, have a completed Class 3 "National Jamboree" physical issued to each participant by the National office of the B.S.A., participate in the local pre-jamboree training, be active in his troop or team for 6 months prior to July 1, 2010, and be approved by his Scoutmaster or Varsity Scout Coach and the Gulf Stream Council Jamboree Committee. His 18th birthday may not be before August 3, 2010*.

Pre-Jamboree Training: ("Shake Down")

The participants will meet as members of a troop four times before attending the Jamboree. One of these is a weekend campout to give the Scouts experience working together as patrols and troops. It is very important that the Scouts commit to attend each of these meetings, as vital information will be given out at these times.

Transportation, Food and Equipment:

A special pre-Jamboree tour will be included along with food, patrol and troop equipment. The total cost will be \$2,200 which will include National Jamboree fees, online registration processing fees, travel and tour expenses, meals, lodging, unit and patrol equipment, accident and sickness insurance, troop numbers, and the cost of pre-jamboree training. The only things not included will be personal equipment and uniforms for the individual Scouts.

Organization:

The participants will be placed in Gulf Stream Council troops consisting of 36 Scouts and 4 adult leaders each. Once the troops are formed and leaders selected, you will receive information through your Jamboree Troop Scoutmaster.

Application:

Overwhelming response is expected due to the 100th Anniversary. You will need to apply early to ensure your place in line, as the slots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. You may reserve a spot with the attached form and a \$200 deposit. All registrations and internet processing fees for contingent participants will be handled within the Gulf Stream Council Service Center and are included in the set \$2,200 price. **All registrations must originate through the Council Service Center to be considered.** Registration through the National Jamboree website **will not** guarantee you a spot in the Gulf Stream Council contingent and National's \$10 processing fee is **nonrefundable** and not a part of the \$2,200 contingent fee.

Refunds: All registrants who are approved for the Jamboree and find that they cannot attend will receive a full refund from the Gulf Stream Council if an alternate is available to replace them. In the event that there is not an alternate, a partial refund may be made after the Jamboree is completed. Deposit fees paid by alternates not selected as active participants will be refunded in full.

Fee Payment Schedule

A deposit of \$200 is required along with the application to attend the Jamboree. This deposit is fully refundable until December 31, 2008. After January 1, 2009 your money is transferable, but not refundable. This deposit is applied to the total Jamboree fee.

The Jamboree fee can be paid in full or according to the following payment schedule. It is essential to keep on schedule because trip commitments have been made and National Jamboree payments are paid on a regular basis.

All Jamboree fees must be paid in full by March 31, 2010. If your application and \$200 deposit are received after March 31, 2009, you must pay the cumulative total due at the date of your deposit and then make monthly payments of \$125 as indicated. In case of financial hardships, alternate arrangements will be considered on an individual basis.
