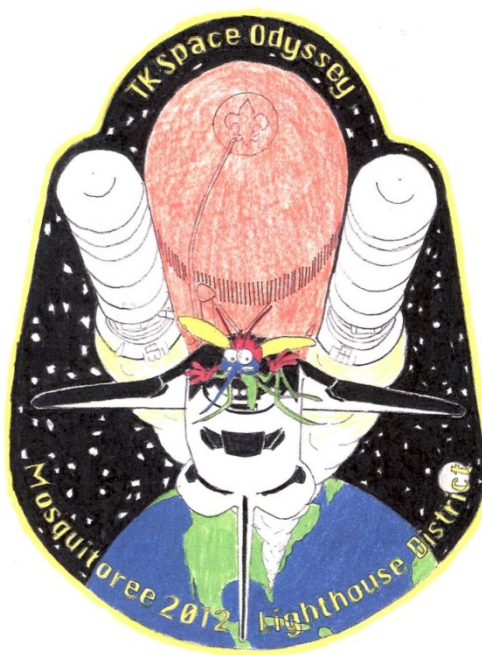

# General Information

# Mosquitoree 2012

## Registration

- Early pack registration ends January 11, 2012. Late registrations will be accepted at the council office until February 8, 2012; after that registrations will be processed at the event. T-shirts and patches are not guaranteed for late registrations.
- Family registrations forms should be turned in to your unit camping/event coordinator with payment no later than January 4, 2012 to allow for processing.
- The maximum cost per family is \$100 with a limit of four (4) shirts and patches with early registration. Additional shirts and patches are available for an additional charge.
- Please sign and date the registration form and keep a copy for your records.

## Unit Camping/Event Coordinators

- Enter camper information online by clicking the *Unit Registration Form* posted on the council calendar or cut and paste the following link into your browser.

- Once all campers are entered, print and submit to council office or event chair at Roundtable with pack payment payable to B.S.A. Gulf Stream Council. Keep a copy for your records.
- Attach credit card payment stubs if applicable. These will be destroyed once payment is processed.
- Packs are responsible that family registration forms are signed for waivers.
- Packs are responsible that B.S.A. health forms are current for each camper and present at the event.

## Pack Activity – Space Shuttle Construction and Launch

- Each Pack will be given materials to construct one (1) shuttle orbiter (water rocket) at check-in.
- Each Pack will launch their shuttle at Saturday's Main Event. Prizes will be awarded for creativity, highest orbit, and shortest orbit among others.
- Decorating materials and other shuttle accessories will not be furnished but are highly recommended to be provided by each Pack.
- Launch pad and crew will be provided by Mosquitoree staff.
- If you are not familiar with water rocket construction, Google search for an endless supply of design and construction ideas. Assemble your team and have fun with it!

## Check-in

- Friday February 17, 5-10pm.
- Saturday February 18, 7-9am for those not able to check-in on Friday.
- Each family must check-in upon arrival. Campers will be given wristbands which must be worn throughout the weekend.
- Pack trailers will be allowed to campsites between 3-4:30 pm on Friday.

## Check-out

- Pack leader must call for campsite check-out prior to leaving.
- All gear must be removed and latrines must be cleaned prior to inspection.
- Pack trailers will be allowed from campsites after inspection.
- Patches will be issued after inspection. No inspection, no patches.

- We will do our best to ensure that campers with special needs are given an opportunity to participate in all Mosquitoree activities. Please contact the event staff for further assistance.
