

Gulf Stream Council Jamboree Contingent 2013

Fee Payment Schedule

A deposit of \$200 is required along with the Jamboree Interest Sheet in order to proceed to the Jamboree Application process. This deposit is fully refundable until December 31, 2011. After January 1, 2012 your money is transferable, but not refundable. This deposit is applied to the total Jamboree fee.

The Jamboree fee can be paid in full or according to the following payment schedule. It is essential to keep on schedule because trip commitments have been made and payments are made to the National Council on a regular basis.

All Jamboree fees must be paid in full by December 31, 2012. If your application and \$200 deposit are received after December 31, 2011, you must pay the cumulative total due on the date of your deposit and then make monthly payments as indicated thereafter. In case of financial hardships, alternate arrangements will be considered on an individual basis.

2013 National Scout Jamboree

Fact Sheet

- Dates:** Jamboree Dates: **July 15 – July 24, 2013**
At The Summit Bechtel Scout Reservation, Glen Jean, WV. Departure from Gulf Stream Council: **approximately 7/12/13**
- Cost:** Cost will be \$1,950 per scout. The Jamboree fee covers all transportation, tours, admission fees, program materials, food, lodging, as well as the use of a tent, cot, dining shelter, stoves, fuel and cooking utensils during your adventure at the Jamboree as well as all costs for the pre-Jamboree training camp. The National fee also includes a “Jambo 13 Kit” consisting of a duffel bag and two activity **shirts** for each contingent member. The only additional expense will be for personal equipment, uniforms and spending money. Travel arrangements may allow for a change in cost. If so, the payment schedule will be adjusted.
- Travel:** Tours and group transportation are still in the planning process. Complete details on the tour will be provided as information becomes available. See the Council website under activities (www.gulfstreamcouncil.org / **Activities /National Scout Jamboree**)
- Organization:** Participants will be placed in one of three Gulf Stream Council troops consisting of 36 Scouts and 4 adult leaders per troop. The Gulf Stream Council contingent is open on a first-come basis. Requirements are as follows:
Must have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout Troop
Must be at least First Class Scout
Must be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree or an 11 year old that has graduated 6th grade, but has not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the Jamboree.
Be approved by the unit leader and the local council
Participate in a pre-jamboree training experience
Have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the council jamboree committee before the pre-jamboree training
Submit all registration fees per the Council payment plan
Once all three troops have been filled, a standby list of alternates will be established.
Adult leaders will be selected by the Council Jamboree Committee and approved by the Council Executive Board. They must be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.

The **Scoutmaster** and **First Assistant Scoutmaster** must have served as a Scoutmaster for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2013, completed Youth Protection training, Scoutmaster Basic Training, and **Wood Badge for the 21st Century**.

Second Assistant Scoutmaster must be at least 21 years of age by July 15, 2013, have completed Youth Protection training, appropriate leader-specific training and have served actively in an adult troop leadership position for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2013.

Third Assistant Scoutmaster must be at least 18 years of age (but not yet 21) by July 15, 2013, have completed Youth Protection training, appropriate leader specific training and have served actively in a troop leadership position. Eagle Scouts only need apply.
- Refunds:** All registrants who are approved for the Jamboree and find that they cannot attend will receive a full refund from the Gulf Stream Council if an alternate is available to replace them. In the event that there is not an alternate, a partial refund may be made after the Jamboree is completed. Deposit fees paid by alternates not selected as active participants will be refunded in full.
