4. No lanterns, stoves, or candles permitted in tents. This equipment to be used by adults only.
5. No alcohol, firearms, BB guns, bows & arrows or sheath knives permitted. Smoking is permitted in parking lot only.
6. Cub Scouts must practice Family Camping rules.
7. No bicycles, skateboards or scooters allowed.
8. Do not climb on any fences or trees.
9. Do not attach anything to trees.
10. No open-toed shoes. (THIS APPLIES TO EVERYONE)
11. No weapons of any kind, this includes plastic and foam.
