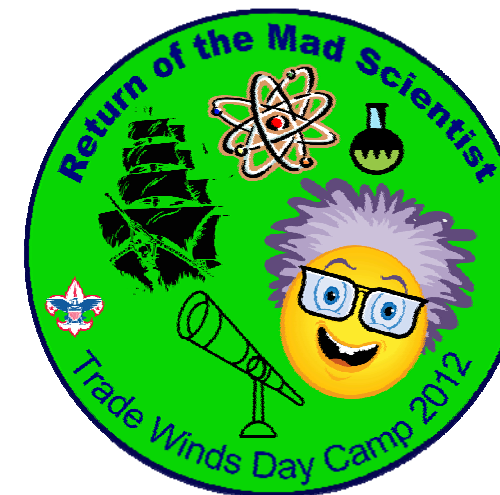

WHO: All registered Cub Scouts (Tigers, Wolves, Bears, and Webelos).

WHERE: Micanopy Pavilion - Okeehelée Park.

WHEN: JUNE 11-15TH, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. **Before and After Care is provided from 7:30—9:00 AM and 4:00—5:30 for \$5 per day.**

FEES: > \$100.00 for each Cub Scout.
> A \$20.00 credit will be given to children of FULL TIME ADULT staff members OR
> A \$25.00 credit will be given to RETURNING FULL TIME ADULT staff members.
> \$10.00 for each extra T-Shirt.
> Fees are transferable but NOT REFUNDABLE!
> Fees include Patch, T-shirt, and all materials.
> Late registrations may possibly not receive a Patch or T-Shirt, pending availability.

UNIFORM: The camp T-Shirt (which MUST be worn each day), shorts, and CLOSED-TOE shoes.

FOOD: Lunch is included. The camp lunch will consist of either a hot dog or hamburger, chips, and a soda. Campers may bring additional items that will not be refrigerated.

TRANSPORT: Each parent is responsible for their Scout's transportation to and from camp.

CAMP STAFF LEADERSHIP: Qualified First Aid is available at all times. Volunteers are needed for a variety of positions including Den Leaders and Program Area Leaders. **EACH PACK MUST PROVIDE ONE FULL TIME ADULT FOR EVERY FIVE SCOUTS IN CAMP, OR ANY PORTION THEREOF.**

Registrations will only be taken at Council until May 25th. After that date, there will be a \$15 additional late registration fee paid at the door.

PROGRAM: Special events, daily crafts, games, sports, guest speakers, nature, songs, skits, cooking, and LOTS OF FUN!

TRADING POST: A trading post will be open daily. Snacks, drinks, souvenirs, and trinkets will be available.

HEALTH FORM: The health form on the back of the registration form / information sheet MUST be completed AND notarized prior to camp.

CAMPERSHIPS: A limited number of need based camperships are being offered. For information on how to apply please contact the Camp Director.

VOLUNTEER TRAINING: A *mandatory* training class will be held for ALL volunteers. Snacks will be provided! Date will be announced soon.

BUDDIES & REGISTRATION: All campers are encouraged to use the "pack registration" system. If you would like to be with a buddy of the same rank please indicate your request on the registration / information form.

CLOSING CEREMONIES: Parents are encouraged to join their sons on Friday afternoon, beginning at noon, for a free lunch, to observe our special afternoon events, and our awards / closing ceremonies.
