### Swimming / Water Rescue Purpose

Training for BSA Swimming & Water Rescue provides BSA leaders with information and skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to swimming emergencies during unit swimming activities. It expands the Safe Swim Defense training. The course takes approximately 8 hours and training is valid for three years. Trained SWR Cards will be issued, after passing required skills and completing the test exam with a score of 80% or higher. This course will be instructed by a BSA Aquatics Instructor and the GSC Aquatics Committee team. This training addresses important informational skills not covered in BSA/ ARC lifeguard training. Class size is limited, so register early. Additional training will be networked as available. Locations may vary. Swimming skills and live-saving skills are recommended. Due to the high demand, adult training (21 years or older) will only be done throughout this weekend. This is not the BSA National Camp School Aquatics Supervisor course.

- Swim Classification Tests & Administration
- Weight Recovery- Pre-requisite
- Revised Safe Swim Defense & Exercises
- Shore based Rescues
- In-water non-contact rescues for active & passive subjects
- Defenses
- Line & Tender Rescue
- In-line stabilization
- Safe area set-up and Snorkeling BSA (If time permits)
- Review & Test- Please, study in advance the Aquatics Supervision review questions

**Prior to class, participants should purchase the BSA Aquatics Supervision Book. To attend this course, the A.S. Book and Health forms are mandatory.
