EAGLE SCOUT ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP
SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be a full time student.
2. Must have obtained the rank of Eagle Scout as a member of a unit in the Gulf Stream Council.
3. Must graduate or have graduated from high school. Must enter a college, university, or other institution of higher learning in the year for which the application for scholarship is made or be enrolled in such institution at the time of application. Additionally, the applicant must not be over the age of 21 when the scholarship is awarded.
4. Complete the Application for Scholarship in its entirety:
 - Section A – High School Record
 - Section B – College/University/Institution Record (if applicable)
 - Section C – Scouting Record
 - Section D – Religious Record
 - Section E – Community Service Activities
5. Demonstrate leadership in Scouting by providing a list of all leadership positions held and the dates the positions were held (Application Section C).
6. Provide information regarding your involvement with your Religious Institution. (Application Section D).
7. Provide a list of achievements outside of Scouting, demonstrating your service to the community. The list should include the name of the organization and number of hours spent in service to that organization (Section E).
8. Provide a certified transcript of the last 6 semesters of education, whether it is from high school, college, or combination of both (Application Section F).
9. Provide a copy of test scores of a minimum of 1300 on The SAT Reasoning Test™ (critical reading, math, and writing) and/or a minimum ACT score of 20 (Application Section F).
10. Provide letters of recommendation from at least one Scout leader and one person outside of the Scouting community who is directly knowledgeable of the caliber of person you are (Application Section F).
11. Provide any other information that would be pertinent to a judge awarding you a scholarship based on merit and leadership (Application Section F).
12. If selected, you must provide an official letter from the college, university, or other institution of higher learning where the scholarship funds are to be sent which:
 - Confirms your status as full time student for the following scholastic term; and
 - Provides contact information including address, phone number and name of a point of contact for where the funds are to be sent.
