



Gulf Stream Council COVID-19 Personal Safety Checklist

Before your outing:

Help us mitigate the risk of illness at our camps and activities.

- Those who present symptoms of illness, have been ill within 14 days prior to arrival at camp, or have been in contact with someone known to have COVID-19 should not attend camp and stay home.
- Those individuals who may have heightened risk factors or are considered vulnerable by the CDC's COVID-19 Guidelines are encouraged to remain home.
- When leaving for camp, complete the Pre-Camp Medical Screening Form and have it ready for check-in at the event. If attending a unit outing at camp, the Unit Leader will collect these forms.

On your outing:

Each of us have a personal responsibility to maintain our own safety.

- Wear a mask when indoors, and outdoors when social distancing cannot or is not being maintained. Be sure your mask or face covering fits snugly over the nose and mouth.
- When possible, maintain at least six feet of distance between participants.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water. Where handwashing cannot be achieved, utilize an alcohol-based hand sanitizer. Apply thoroughly.
