

SAW 2020 at TK Information

Gulf Stream Council Scouts only!

Registration – sign up as an individual to speed up the check in process, Units can sign up, but check in will be by each scout. You can sign up for TK in person classes and virtual classes! **Registration for in person classes at TK opens on October 3rd at 8am for Gulf Stream Council Scouts only.**

****Virtual Online registration will start October 10th , separate registration – All Councils.**

Leadership – this year at SAW, adult leaders are not required, we will have dedicated SAW Staff as the Camp Leaders. **That means you cannot come hang around with your scout unless you are on staff.**

Event - Classes - 8:30am until 5:30pm, check starts at 7:30am at the welcome pavilion.

Scout Drop off Saturday morning – check points as you enter TK, temperature check, wristband, Covid medical screening sheet handed in, registration check in.

Safety requirements – ALL participants at TK must always wear a mask, while in class where social distancing is practical, masks may be removed to complete class tasks.

Check in – Check in by individual scout, receive class location, t-shirt, patch at check in.

Wristbands – must be worn during the entire event.

T-shirts – adult sizes only!!

Classes sizes - have been set per the GSC guidelines for Covid 19, we cannot squeeze another scout in, so please do not email or call and ask. Event limited to 300.

Blue cards - will be available thru your tentaroo account, the same system you used to register, after the event, you will be responsible to get the blue cards back to your troop advancement chair.

Lunch - will be provided at TK – Sandwich, chips, cookie, & bottle of water.

Water - will be available from water coolers throughout the day in each class site, bring your own cup...if you are not comfortable drinking from a cooler, you may bring your own bottled water.

Health Officers - will be on duty the entire event, Health Lodge located at the end of the Lassiter building.

Trading Post will be open – follow the guideline posted for entrance.

Swim Test - is required and will be performed before each Aquatics Merit Badge class.

Virtual Campfire - Saturday night – get you skits & songs ready! More info to follow and a zoom link.

What to bring:

Personal water bottle or canteen – water - if you do not want to drink water from a cooler.

Hat, sunscreen, carry bag, etc...

Personal gear & swimwear, if doing any aquatics classes

Completed pre-reqs, if required by your class. Pen or pencil for class, Merit badge book.

What to wear: All adults & Scouts are encouraged to wear the Class A uniform or activity uniform appropriate for their level of scouting. SAW t-shirts present & past are permitted during the event.

Clothing with inappropriate pictures or language are not permitted.

Closed toe shoes only, no sandals.

No camping during the event.

No registrations or class changes at the event.

Cancellations & Refunds – cancellation from participation must be made by November 16th, refund request must be received no later than five business days after the event.
