As of January 1st, 2021, the South Florida Science Center and Aquarium is proud to have achieved the **GBAC STAR™** Facility Accreditation! Under the guidance of GBAC, a Division of ISSA, the worldwide cleaning industry association, we have implemented the most stringent protocols for cleaning, disinfection, and infectious disease prevention throughout our facilities.

SAFETY GUIDELINES:

- As of May 15th, 2021: Per recent CDC guidelines driven by scientific evidence, face coverings are no longer required for fully vaccinated guests. The CDC continues to strongly recommend the use of face coverings for those that have yet to get vaccinated.
- Use the touchless hand sanitizing stations and wash hands frequently.
- All surfaces are thoroughly disinfected every hour.
- We have 3D-printed personal "button-pushers" available for rent or purchase at the admissions desk so guests can safely interact with some of our hands-on-exhibits without touching them.

We expect everyone in Scouting to follow the measures listed below, which are based on CDC guidance.

- Isolate if you are sick, and do not attend any activity/meeting/event if you, anyone you live with, or anyone you have recently been around feels unwell.
- Do not attend any activity/meeting/event if you or anyone you live with has been tested for COVID-19 or another illness and does not have the results back yet.
- If you are not fully vaccinated, wear [a face covering or mask that covers your nose and mouth](#) and stay at least 3 feet apart from people you don't live with.
- [Wash your hands often](#) with soap and water. Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
