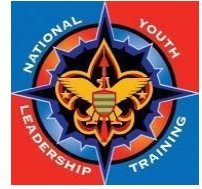




National Youth Leadership Training

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is the current incarnation of youth leadership development training offered by the Boy Scouts of America. NYLT is a six-day outdoor training experience for the Boy Scouts, Venturing, and Sea Scout youth leaders as an important part of the leadership training continuum of the Boy Scouts of America.

The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what they must **KNOW**, and what they must **DO**. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on **HOW TO**. The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a quest for the meaning of leadership.

NYLT provides a toolbox of essential leadership skills, the ability to set and achieve goals, the confidence, and experience necessary to run their Unit, and an opportunity to share ideas and experiences with other Scouts from around the Council. *This is an outdoor training course. Scouts will be participating in activities that require hiking, cooking, and camping in any weather. **Participants must attend the full week of training to receive the certificate of completion.**

Cost:

- \$300.00** per participant if made by 11/01/23.
- \$325.00** per participant after 11/1/2023.

Pre-Requisites to Attend:

- Scouts, Sea Scouts, & Venturers who are 13 years old, but not yet 21.
- First Class Scouts or Venturing equivalent.
- Currently serving in a troop/crew position of responsibility.
- Recommended / approved by Scoutmaster or Venturing Crew Advisor.

Required Forms:

- Medical A, B & C Forms (signed within 1 year of course start date)
- Online Application: Participant
- Online Approval Form: From Parent / Guardian
- Online Approval Form: From Leader

Behavior:

All scouts are expected to behave according to the Scout Oath and Law. Bullying or hazing will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the course. No refunds will be made if the scout is dismissed from the course.

Uniforms:

BSA Training is done wearing the Class-A uniform. During field training, however, Class-B t-shirts can be worn, providing they're scouting appropriate. **Two NYLT t-shirts will be provided with registration.**

- Class-A uniform: Shirt, shorts / pants, belt & socks.
- Class-B uniform: Scouting appropriate t-shirt, shorts/pants.

Equipment:

Participants will be assigned to a Patrol, and will attend learning sessions together, as well as eat and camp together in a nearby campsite.

- Tent (hammocks are not allowed under pavilions)
- Sleeping Bag
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Backpack / Duffel (trunk is not recommended)
- Flashlight
- Six (6) days of clothing, including Class-A uniform
- Light Jacket / Windbreaker
- Hiking shoes or boots
- Personal First Aid kit
- Water Bottle / Nalgene
- Shower essentials, including towel(s) and close-toed shoes
- Mess kit

Prescription Medicines:

NYLT Medical Officer will be responsible for dispensing prescription medication to participants.

- Medication sent on an outing should preferably be in its original container and labeled with the name of the participant, medication, dosage and strength, prescribing health-care provider's name, date of prescription, current instructions for use, special storage, etc.
- If a prescription label is missing or placed on an external package, the internal item (such as a tube or inhaler) should be, at a minimum, labeled with the participant's name, name of the medication, and directions for use.

Cellular Phones and Electronic Devices:

Personal cell phones are not necessary and can be a distraction during class and at camp. The Staff is equipped with radios, for emergency and communication purposes. In addition, the training will leave very little free time, so electronic devices are not necessary. **Please Do NOT send your Scouts to NYLT with ANY ELECTRONICS.**

Prohibited Items:
